

REQUIRED MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES – 2023- 2024

*Each student should come prepared the first day of school with the following materials.
Thereafter, students need to replenish these materials during the school year.
A student who learns to prepare is prepared to learn.*

KINDERGARTEN



ALL GRADES:

1. Put your student's name on all jackets, sweatshirts, lunch pails, backpacks, **etc.**
2. NO FELT OR MARKING PENS ARE ALLOWED ON SCHOOL PREMISES.
3. School supplies such as notebooks and/or lockers are NOT to be decorated with pictures, slogans, fad personalities, radio stations, derogatory writing or anything else that detracts from a Christian school environment.

TEXTBOOKS & WORKBOOKS:

1. Kindergarten students will not receive textbooks, instead, students will be issued "consumables" – fillable workbooks will be kept in the classroom.
2. Workbooks will be issued at the start of the school year. They are designed to supplement the teacher's textbooks. There is a replacement fee for lost or damaged workbooks.

KINDERGARTNERS:

1. Kindergartners do NOT need a backpack. The storage space is limited, and backpacks are better suited to the needs of students in 1st grade and above.
2. Your student should bring crayons, (Crayola) markers, dry erase marker, color pencils and glue sticks in a pencil box with their name on it.
3. Pencils will be issued to students during the first week of school.
4. Students will need crayons, glue, scissors, and a stapler at home to complete homework assignments.



KINDERGARTEN: FULL DAY STUDENTS - AFTERNOON DAY CARE - 12:05 to 2:50.

1. A small crib sized rest mat labeled with child's name. Rest mats may be purchased in the school office for \$15.00.
2. Students may bring blanket, pillow or stuffy to accompany their rest mat. These items will be given to families at the end of the week to be washed at home, items are to be brought back in the following Monday. All items are to be labeled and will be kept in a x-large Ziplock bag in the kindergarten room.
